

The regulatory landscape

What is the EUDR?

- The EUDR repeals the EUTR.
- As of 29 June 2023, operators and traders will have 18 months to implement the new rules. Micro and small companies will enjoy a longer adaptation period, as well as other specific provisions.

The EUDR aims to:

- 1. Avoid that the listed products Europeans buy, use and consume contribute to deforestation and forest degradation in the EU and globally
- 2. Reduce carbon emissions caused by EU consumption and production of the relevant commodities by at least 32 million metric tonnes a year
- 3. Address all deforestation driven by agricultural expansion to produce the commodities in the scope of the regulation, as well as forest degradation

What are the main criteria?

The products in question shall not be placed or made available on the market nor exported unless all the following conditions are met:



Deforestation-free



Compliant with the relevant legislation of the country of production



Subject to a due diligence statement


